SALVATION CONSIDERATION FOR CHRISTIANS, BASED ON BIBLICAL VERSES

WHY WILL MOST PEOPLE WHO BELIEVE THEY ARE CHRISTIANS BE REJECTED BY JESUS?

(NOTE:PAGES 4-7 PRESENT REFERENCED BIBLE VERSES, ITALICS ADDED)

People assuming that they and others will be accepted as Christians by Jesus on judgement day might consider:

Matthew 6:14-15 — "For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not mentheir trespasses, neither will your Fatherforgive your trespasses."

Matthew 7:21-23 — "Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then I profess unto them, I never new you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

Matthew 7:13-14 — "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

Luke 6:46 — "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?"

Ephesians 2:8 — "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God"

WHAT DOES FAITH (BELIEF) IN JESUS INVOLVE?

If **faith** (**belief**) only involves accepting Jesus, **Ephesians 2:8** begs the question why all people who accept Jesus will not be accepted by Him rather than just a few? Matthew appears to present a contradiction to Paul in Ephesians.

Faith (belief) has more components. (1) Receiving Jesus plus, (2) obedience to His commands to confirm your Christian belief.

Your personally chosen works are a separate item from obeying His commands, but important and determine your rewards if you get to Heaven, once you have (1) become a Christian by accepting Jesus & (2) obey His commands. (**TITUS 1:16**)

The free gift of Jesus's blood covers your **confessed sins** to get you into heaven once you have applied the power He gave you to become a son of God. (**John 1:12**)

John 1:12— "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:"

John 15:14— "Ye are myfriends, if ye do whatsoever I command you."

James 2:20— "But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?"

BELIEF OF DEVILS — (James 2:19) "Thou believist that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe and tremble."

People who believe they are Christians have to do better than devils for Jesus to know them on judgement day.

WHY WILL MOST PEOPLE WHO ASSUME THEY ARE CHRISTIANS BE REJECTED?

2 Timothy4:3-4—"For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching **ears**; And they shall turn away their **ears** from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables."

"Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

This statement implies sacrifices in obeying Jesus's commands are **difficult**, but must be made on the way to life. As per **Malachi1:8** substandard sacrifices are evil.

"For if we sin willfully afterwe have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins," (Hebrews10:26)

OUR CHRISTIAN ACTIVITIES (WORKS) SHOULD BE CONSIDERED AS TWO CATEGORIES

1) ACTING IN OBEDIENCE TO THE COMMANDS OF JESUS is necessary to confirm our Christian position beyond the understanding of devils (James 2:19), which only accepts His existence (John 1:12).

Your acceptance into Heaven is based primarily on the Grace of Jesus, a freely given gift, provided by His sacrifice on the cross; however, obeying His commands to confirm your Christian belief is also required to become His friend.

Jesus states "Ye are my friends if you do whatsoever I command you." (John 15:14)

Acting out our works, both good and bad, of personal choice will be judged by Jesus on judgement day. He will judge all of our actions, every word we spoke and every thought we had.

Our salvation is not based on our personal works of choice, but they will influence our eternal existence in Heaven. (Revelation 20:13)

Many Christians say climate change and protecting all children is not their problem and they cannot help.

Jesus says He will give us the knowledge to help if we ask and He commanded stewardship of the earth and protection of children. James 1:5, Isaiah 1:18, John 15:5, Matthew 6:14, Matthew 18:6, Matthew 21:22

THE FIRST TWO COMMANDS HE GAVE US INGENESIS 1:28 AND GENESIS 2:15 WERE:

(THEREAREMORE COMMANDMENTS FOR US TO FIND AND UNDERSTAND)

1) Be good stewards of the earth.

Do not allow or cause destruction of the earth by your actions or nonactions. (Nonaction is sin **James 4:17**) **God's response to disobedience: Revelation11:18**—"and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth."

2) Go forth and multiply.

Protect children from climate change, etc. and promote natural reproduction of humanity by not offending children by your actions or nonactions. **James 4:17, 1Timothy5:8** and **Matthew18:6**.

Some Bible verses addressing lipservice are 1 John 2:4, 1 John 3:18, Matthew 15:8, Galatians 6:7 and TITUS 1:16.

The commands of Jesus must be honoured by Christians to totally fulfill our faith (belief).

Good works of your choice cannot compensate for disobedience to the commands of Jesus.

TWO BIBLICAL AREAS OF CHRISTIAN DISOBEDIENCE ARE:

1) Only token or no effort, (lame sacrifice **Malachi1:8**) as stewards, to address climate change, ignoring:

Genesis 2:15:

"And the LORD Godtook the man, and put him into the Garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it."

Genesis1:28:

"And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth."

2) Not providing for (protecting) children from negative influences. "But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel." (1Timothy 5:8)

Not addressing climate change and taking no action to address the LGBTQIA2S+effort to indoctrinate children from the natural flow of human reproduction to the LGBTQIA2S+lifestyle, defies Jesus's commands. "And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the Garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it." and "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth,".
